Chasin Limits Tournament Guidelines

This tournament is about the kids and their chance to win some prizes so keep that perspective.

1. Tournament registration opens August 1st and closes September 4th. \$60 per team. After that, those who register late will blast off after the ones who pre-registered with a launch number in order of late registration.
2. Each angler and boat captain must have completed registration with a liability waiver.
3. Student Anglers are current 6th – 12th grade Middle/High School Students. Student Anglers can fish as a team of (2) student anglers or choose to fish solo with the boat captain.
4. Boat captains:
 - 21 years of age or older and provide a current insurance liability policy of at least \$300,000
 - Will run the main engine, can run the trolling motor and can help net fish.
 - Will not fish or even touch a rod or the team will be disqualified. Let the kids do the fishing.
5. SCDNR fishing rules and regulations apply during tournaments, including fishing license and boating regulations.
6. Tournament consists of a 5 fish per limit, 12" length. Teams can not possess more than 5 fish at any time during the tournament. Extra fish must be culled immediately on the water. Small fish will be disqualified.
7. Boats must be equipped with a properly working live well with aeration in effort to keep fish alive till released after weigh-in
8. Dead fish cannot be culled and must be kept & weighed in as part of the 5 fish limit. A .25 pound penalty for each dead fish will be assessed off the total weight.
9. All fish must be caught on artificial lures, and anglers may only use one rod at a time. Trolling is not permitted and fish must be caught from the boat.
10. Timeline: *Bucksport has 2 ramps so come early to launch and dock your boat*

5:30	Pick Up Weigh-In Card	6:30	Captains Meeting then Launch
2:00	Weigh-ins open	3:00	Cards due by 3:00 or team is DQ
