## 2020 FCA Fishing Tournament Rules

1. Only artificial lures can be used during competition. Applies to Redfish division and Bass Division. Only one fishing rod can be used at a time per angler.
2. LIMITS – **Bass division:** Five (5) bass limit. Length limits is 12” minimum. **Redfish Division:** 15”-23” size limit for any fish weighed in. A four (4) ounce penalty will be deducted for each dead fish weighed. The four (4) ounce penalty will be deducted from the teams total weight. A team bringing a short fish to the scales will lose the short fish and their big fish. A team bringing more than five (5) bass to the scales will results in loss of the team’s tournament Big Fish. A team must have a working live well. Once a teams bag has been weighed their cannot be a 2nd weigh for any reason.
3. TEAMS- One person must be at least 18 on each team. 3 person limit per team. Only one team per boat. **Teams can only fish in one division.** Participants **should wear a face buff/mask** when weighing in their fish, and must use **social distancing** during the weigh in and event hours when on dry land.
4. Big Fish- Optional \$5 for big fish. Biggest weight will win big fish. Tie will be split in half to winners.
5. Legal Fishing Areas/ Boundaries: No fishing beyond locked gates.
6. BLAST-OFF – Blast-off spots will be based on pre-registration. Teams registered online before midnight on 8/23/20 will blast off in first flight. Teams registered after that and morning of will blast off 5 minutes after the first flight teams are finished. **1<sup>st</sup> Blast off spot will be available for bid starting 8/1/20.**
7. CULL RULE – Fish must be culled when the five (5) fish limit is reached for the bass division. Fish must be culled when the 2 fish limit is reached for redfish division. Not culling will results in one (1) warning. Second violation will result in disqualification.
8. TIES – Each team will have a Big Fish weighed in order to break a total weight tie
9. Late Penalty- Cards will be given out at time of check-in and livewell inspection. Redfish division cards due by 2:30pm, and Bass Division Cards are due by 3:00pm. Teams will be disqualified if turned in after those times.
10. ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS, & FELONS – No alcohol or illegal drugs may be consumed during tournament hours. Anyone who has been convicted of a felony in the past 7 years from tournament date will not be allowed to enter an FCA event.
11. LIFE JACKET – A life jacket for each angler must be worn when the big motor is turned on. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. Life vests must be Coast Guard approved. **Excessive speed and reckless driving will result in disqualification.**
12. BOATS - Any boat equipped with a motor exceeding the Coast Guard approved rating for the boat will not be allowed for use in an FCA event. Jet drive engines are not allowed during both official practice and competition. Boats must be a minimum of 15 feet. **A working livewell is required.**
13. GAS CAN & JUGS – No gas can be placed on the bank before or during the event. Gas cannot be brought to a team for the sole purpose of enabling the team to advance to other fishing areas or in order to travel back to the weigh-in location. Gas may be obtained from a marina that is available to all participants. Any extra gas cans permitted **must be fitted with quick release plugs or valve switches.**
14. PROTESTS – All protests should be made to the FCA or SALT Director be brought to the directors’ attention immediately after weigh-in is concluded. Any protest brought at a later time will not be reviewed. All FCA Director (Ryan Marsh) and SALT Director (Rayburn Poston) decisions are final!
15. Inclement Weather- Alternative ramps may be used if the event date is subject to inclement weather. Decision will be made by the captains meeting. Weigh in would still be held at Carroll Campbell at regular time.
