# Tournament Rules

1. Entry Fee: \$130.00 per boat (including Big Fish). Two member team recommended. Entry fee can be paid at the launch site.
2. Registration: Registration must be postmarked by June 8, 2019 to be eligible for Early Bird. Mail registration form and entry fee to either of the addresses below:

3. Contact Numbers: Joe Gamble (843-997-3144) or William Fredrick (843-833-4945).
4. Blast Off is at "Safe Light," rain or shine. Boats will blast off according to registration. All boats *must meet* South Carolina Safe Boat Requirements. Life jackets must be worn any time boat is on a plane.
5. Limit: 5 Bass per boat with a 12" minimum measured on golden rule. (A courtesy check will be available.
6. Equipment: Artificial lures only! No rod over 8 ft. in length. No cane poles or extension poles allowed in the boat.
7. Winner: Will be determined by most pounds of largemouth bass per boat.
8. Big Fish: The largest bass in creel. Only one (1) big fish per boat is eligible.
9. Ties: Will be broken by largest fish in creel. Further ties broken by flip of a coin.
10. Dead Fish: .25 lbs. per fish will be removed from the total weight and will become the property of Sampit Bassmasters.
11. Live Fish: Every effort should be made to keep fish alive by use of properly aerated live well. All live fish will be released.
12. All fish must be landed from your boat.
13. No fishing within 25 yards of another boat.
14. Legal fishing Area: All waters must be reached by boat (no trailing is allowed.) Ditches or waterways that are locked are illegal and is off limits to all participants.
15. Weigh-in: Any boats returning after 3:30 p.m. will be penalized by one (1) pound per minute, then will be disqualified after 3:35 p.m.
16. Weigh-in Bags: You may use your own weigh-in bag. Only 5 contestants at the scales at a time, please.
17. Reckless Driving: Will not be tolerated. You will be disqualified.
18. Protests: Protests must be presented in writing to the Tournament Director within ten (10) minutes after the weigh in has been completed. Competitors found accusing others of violation of rules without formally filing a protest may be charged with unsportsmanlike conduct and **DISQUALIFIED FROM TOURNAMENT AS WELL AS FUTURE TOURNAMENTS OF THE SAMPIT BASSMATERS.**
