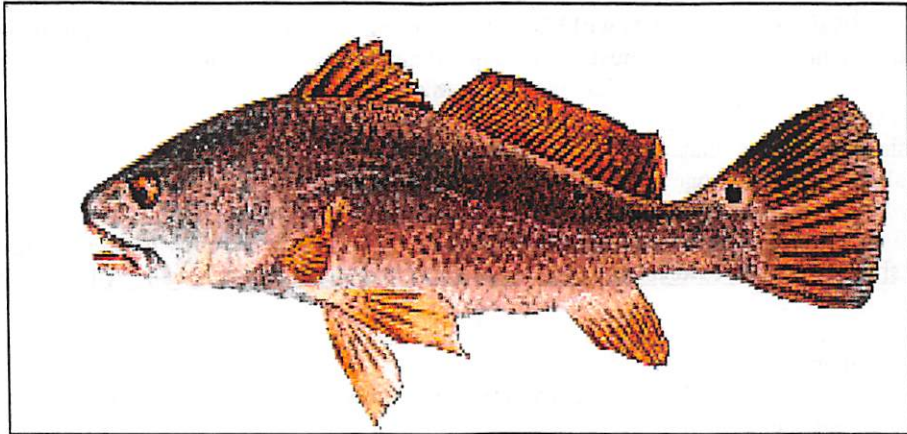

Tournament Rules

- 1. Entry Fee: \$100.00 per Boat (Includes Big Fish). Two member teams only. Entry fee can be paid at the launch site.
- 2. Registration: Early bird registration must be postmarked by June 8, 2019.

- 3. Contact Numbers: Joe Gamble – 843-997-3144 or William Fredrick – 843-833-4945.
- 4. Blastoff is at "Safe Light." (Rain or Shine) Boats will blast off according to registration. All boats *must meet* South Carolina Safe Boat Requirements. Life jackets must be worn any time boat is on a plane.
- 5. Limit: 2 Red fish per boat with a 15" minimum to 23" maximum (slot size).
- 6. Equipment: Artificial lures only.
- 7. Winner: Will be determined by most pounds of Red fish per boat.
- 8. Big Fish: The largest fish in creel. Only one (1) big fish per boat is eligible.
- 9. Ties: Will be broken by largest fish in creel. Further ties broken by flip of a coin.
- 10. Dead Fish: .25 lbs. Per fish will be removed from the total weight and will become property of Sampit Bassmasters.
- 11. Live Fish: Every effort should be made to keep fish alive by use of properly aerated live well. All live fish will be released.
- 12. All fish must be landed from your boat.
- 13. No fishing within 25 yards of another boat.
- 14. Legal fishing area: All waters must be reached by boat (no trailing is allowed). Ditches or waterways that are locked are illegal and is off limits to all participants.
- 15. Weigh In: Any boats returning after 4:00 p.m., will be penalized by one (1) pound per minute, then will be disqualified after 4:05 p.m. Disabled boats must be towed to be eligible. Fish may be sent by another contestant providing one partner accompanies their catch.
- 16. Weigh-In Bags: Bags will be issued at weigh-in.
- 17. Reckless driving will not be tolerated. You will be disqualified!
- 18. Protests: Protests must be presented in writing to the Tournament Director within ten minutes after the weigh-in has been completed. Competitors found accusing others of violation of rules without formally filing a protest may be charged with unsportsmanlike conduct and **DISQUALIFIED FROM TOURNAMENT AS WELL AS FUTURE TOURNAMENTS OF SAMPIT BASSMATERS.**
- 19. Polygraph: All contestants are subject to a polygraph test. Failure will result in disqualification.
- 20. When returning from launch site to weigh-in station, any boat leaving the line will be disqualified.
- 21. ***Sampit Bassmasters Reserves The Right To Refuse Any Application For This Tournament.***
